- **in the case of sole traders, a statement of audited accounts for the last 3 years;**
- **information in relation to any relevant offences the applicant stands convicted of, either in the State or elsewhere (section 6 of the Act refers);**
- **a certified copy of any/all current licence(s), in the applicable category, issued in the State or another EU state;**
- **proof that the applicant has registered as a data controller with the Data Protection Commissioner.**
