This form **must** be accompanied by the following:

- Written confirmation from the Police Authorities in the applicant's country of residence that he/she has or has not been convicted of any relevant offences in that jurisdiction (section 6 of the Act refers)
- originals of the newspaper notices declaring the applicant's intention to apply for a certificate of personal fitness dated at least 14 days prior to the application being made;
- in the case of **corporate bodies**, an Auditor's Certificate for the last 3 years for which they are legally obliged to submit accounts, as well as detailed accounts for the same period ;
- in the case of **sole traders**, a statement of audited accounts for the last 3 years;
- a certified copy of any/all current licence(s), in the applicable category, issued in the State or another EU state;
